Shell Awards

The six works judged best by the selection panel will be purchased by Shell and each artist will receive a Shell Award of £200 in addition to the purchase price. The winning works will be displayed in Kirkcaldy Galleries, and following this, they will be presented to Fife hospitals and health care facilities.

Procedures

Works will be included in the exhibition provided they meet the criteria listed overleaf. The decision of the exhibition organiser is final. The artwork on display will be judged by an independent panel from both the visual arts and healthcare sectors.

Any work rejected for hanging can be collected between Wednesday 3rd and Friday 5th October.

New Prize, - Youth Award

This year there will be a Youth Award, a 3D/Craft Award and four 2D Awards. The Youth Award is open to those aged between 14 and 24 years. The artwork submitted for the Youth Award must have been created outwith school or college. The emphasis is on young people pursuing the creation of artwork in their own time. Artwork submitted for this category must be clearly labelled 'Youth Award'.

Who can submit work?

The Fife Art Exhibition is open to all amateur artists living in Fife who are not currently taking or have not completed full-time degree or diploma art courses. Artists who have attended weekend, evening or similar classes are welcome, including artists who have successfully sold work.

What kind of work?

Only one work per artist can be submitted for display in 2018, (to allow enough room to display work from the increasing number of exhibitors.)

Any medium - painting, sculpture, photography, jewellery, pottery, embroidery, etc.

All works must be offered for sale at a realistic price. The maximum purchase price is £800. The design or composition must be the artist's original work. Needlework and painting kits will not be accepted. Découpage can only be accepted if the main image or images in the piece are the original work of the artist. Images taken from magazines, greetings cards or other printed sources cannot be accepted. No work submitted to previous Fife Art Exhibitions (sponsored by Shell), will be accepted. Artwork must be the sole work of the artist, collaborations are not permitted.

How should it be presented?

All work must be ready for immediate hanging or display.

9:30am - 5pm, Saturday 8th September 9:30 - 2pm

NB - The centre is closed on Sundays

Private Viewing

The awards will be announced at a private viewing event on **Tuesday 2nd October (7-9pm)**. Invitations will be issued when work is submitted.

After the exhibition

Purchasers and exhibitors can collect work on **Thursday 22nd, and Friday 23rd November (9:30am - 5pm) or Saturday 24th November (9:30 - 2pm)**

No works may be removed before the end of the exhibition. Any works not collected by end of December 2018 will be donated to charity. Please note that packing materials cannot be stored at Lochgelly Centre. Please supply these yourself when you come to collect your work.

Lochgelly Centre does not accept liability for damage to works incurred while not on the premises.

Sale of work

The gallery staff will accept payment from the private viewing on Tuesday 2nd October onwards. Cheques should be made payable to: Fife Cultural Trust. Artists should receive payment by cheque by the end of 2018. Payment will be selling price less 30% (25% commission and VAT)
